

Fall 2012- 2017 Health & Wellness Survey Executive Summary

The 2017 Health & Wellness Survey was administered to measure student perceptions regarding three domains: health, personal safety, and substance use/perceptions. The survey administered via the online portal to a **random sample of 4,000** full-time undergraduate students. Of the 4,000 students selected, **1,077** students participated in 2017.
